

## **VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES WITH RESCORLA FESTIVAL!**

- **ORAL HISTORY INTERVIEWERS/ASSISTANTS**

**DESCRIPTION/DUTIES:** As part of the Rescorla Festival Project we are collecting recorded interviews with people about life in the Clay Country and its customs and traditions. As an oral history interviewer and/or assistant you can help us with some or all of the following tasks: Finding and approaching potential interviewees; setting up interviews; conducting and recording interviews and producing interview summaries. Full training and instruction pack will be given. If you find the role interesting there may be further opportunities to do more with our partner organisation, the Cornish Audio Visual Archive

**SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS:** No experience necessary, full training given.

**WHERE AND WHEN:** Interviews may be set up at your own convenience and the project will take place from now until December 2008. One of our team will provide training and let you know about events you may like to attend.

- **RESCORLA FESTIVAL STEWARD/PARKING MARSHALL**

**DESCRIPTION:** Required to help Marshall the parking fields, provide information and assistance to the general public and oversee the event to ensure things are running smoothly.

**SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS:** No experience necessary but any previous experience an advantage.

**WHERE AND WHEN:** In the village of Rescorla, near St Austell, on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> and/or Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2008. One of our team will meet you on-site before the event to provide a full briefing.

- **RESCORLA FESTIVAL/ROADSHOW ASSISTANTS**

**DESCRIPTION:** To provide assistance in setting up and running the Rescorla Festival and associated roadshow events around the district. Specific tasks may include setting up equipment and displays, preparing/serving drinks and refreshments, helping with tidying and litter picking, providing assistance to the general public and visitors.

**SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS:** No experience necessary and full training offered. Experience of helping with or organising events (of any size) a benefit.

**WHERE AND WHEN:** At the Festival from 27 – 29<sup>th</sup> June 2008 and also at a series of roadshow events across the Clay Country (please contact us for dates)

- **RESEARCHERS**

**DESCRIPTION/DUTIES:** As part of the Rescorla Festival Project we are researching the history, customs and traditions of the Clay Country. You could help by looking through books, old newspapers or other archive material. You could do this at your local library, the Cornwall Centre, or you may be able to find things out in the local community.

**SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS:** Full training given, some experience of research an advantage but not essential.

**WHERE AND WHEN:** The project will take place from now until December 2008 and you would be able to undertake research at your own convenience during this period. One of our team will contact you and fully brief you on the project. You may also benefit from attending our events.
